Policy on Admission of Students in Various Courses Offered by College

Zakir Husain Delhi College (Evening), a constituent college of University of Delhi, remains steadfast in its commitment to upholding the highest standards of academic integrity and transparency in its admission procedures. Guided by the directives and policies set forth by the university for each academic session, the college ensures that every aspect of the admissions process aligns with the principles of equity, fairness, and inclusivity.

In line with the progressive initiatives of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and the subsequent adoption of the Undergraduate Curriculum Framework (UGCF) 2022, the college offers admission to a diverse range of courses through a combination of entrance-based and merit-based procedures. This approach, in accordance with the guidelines established by the university, reflects the college's unwavering commitment to providing equal opportunities for all deserving candidates, regardless of their background or circumstances.

The admission process at Zakir Husain Delhi College (Evening) is meticulously structured to ensure efficiency and transparency at every stage:

Step 1: Prior to admissions commencement, the college diligently forms various committees within the staff council to oversee the smooth execution of the process. Experienced faculty members and administrators comprise these committees, tasked with addressing the multifaceted aspects of admissions such as coordination, grievance resolution, and extracurricular activities (ECA), and sports quotas. Additionally, they appoint liaison officers to ensure the equitable implementation of admissions policies for categories like Other Backward Classes (OBC), Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Economic Weaker Sections (EWS), and Persons with Disability (PwD).

Step 2: The College proactively communicates any decisions regarding the relaxation of cutoff percentages for female applicants to the university, demonstrating its commitment to promoting gender equity and inclusivity in higher education.

Step 3: Well in advance of the admission process, the college releases a comprehensive prospectus or admission brochure which contains essential information about the institution, its academic programmes, infrastructure, and extracurricular activities. This document serves as a valuable resource for prospective applicants, enabling them to make informed decisions about their educational journey.

Step 4: Admissions to all programmes are conducted through a centralized system established by the university, adhering to the guidelines outlined in the Common University Entrance Examination (CUET) 2022. The college's admission committee ensures strict compliance with the directives issued by the University of Delhi, overseeing the fair and transparent selection process for all applicants.



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Step 5: Applicants seeking admission to the college, assigned by the university as per its discretion, undergo thorough eligibility verification by the college authorities. An enquiry counter is established within the college premises to address inquiries from parents and applicants, providing essential guidance and support throughout the admission process. In cases where admissions fall under categories such as OBC/SC/ST/EWS/PWD, liaison officers meticulously oversee additional verification processes, ensuring the integrity and authenticity of submitted certificates.

Step 6: The College promptly notifies applicants to proceed with the payment of fees upon successful verification. The college grants provisional admission upon fee payment, marking a significant milestone in the enrollment process. Final approval of admissions is contingent upon validation by the university, underscoring the importance of adherence to established procedures and standards.

Step 7: Upon the conclusion of the admission process, the list of admitted students is promptly published on the university admission portal. This transparent dissemination of information ensures accessibility to pertinent details for all stakeholders, facilitating a seamless transition into academic life at Zakir Husain Delhi College (Evening) and fostering a culture of accountability and inclusivity.

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
